General Items

- Alarm Clock
- Bath Towels
- Blanket
- Cart/dolly to transport Items
- CAT-5 Cable
- Chest Case/Storage Bins
- Cleaning Supplies*
- Clothes Hangers
- Computer
- Desk Lamp (with fireproof shades, NO wicker or plastic)
- DVD Player
- Ethernet Cord
- Extra-long twin sheets
- Fan (Desk/Floor/Window)
- Flashlight with batteries
- Iron/Ironing Board
- Laundry Bag/Basket
- Laundry Detergent
- Light Bulbs
- Mattress pad/mattress cover
- Pad Locks for closets and drawers
- Pillows/pillow cases
- Reusable Plastic Items: plates, utensils, and storage containers
- Stereo/Radio
- Surge Protectors
- Television equip with QAM Tuner
- Trash can/Trash bags
- Twin Sized bedding
- Sleeping Bag (Emergency Use Only)

Personal Care/Hygiene Items

For Classes and Studying

- Computer paper

Prohibited Items

- Appliances without automatic shutoff
- A/C units, Humidifiers or Dehumidifiers without doctor's statement
- Dimmer switches
- Extension cords, or Ceiling Fans
- Family heirlooms or valuables
- Flammable liquids, substances
- George Foreman/Skillets
- Hot plates, microwaves, mini refrigerators or toasters (Micro-fridges are provided in the residence halls)
- Hover boards
- Hookahs/E-cigarettes
- Illegal Drugs or Alcohol
- Incense burning devices or candles or any electrical air fresheners
- Lofts
- Martial Arts weapons
- Nails, or tacks (thumbtacks)
- Pets (fish are an exception in a tank no larger than 20 gallons)
- Plug in Air Fresheners (Airwick, Glade, etc.)
- Removable Command Strips
- Space Heaters
- Toasters
- Weapons: Knives, guns, etc.

Standard Amenities Provided

- Bed (Twin extra-long mattress(36x80))
- Two 2-draw dresser or one 3-draw dresser depending on the Residence Hall
- Desk and Chair
- Micro-Fridge (1 per traditional double occupancy room or 2 per suite area)
- Closet/wardrobe/cubby storage area
- Cable and Internet (Wi-Fi)
