

The STI introduces students to:

- Career opportunities in the public and private sectors of transportation and supply chain management;
- Specific industries and modes of transportation, encompassing air, highway, rail, transit and water;
- How a STEM skill set is essential in transportation fields.

Learning includes classroom lectures, field trips, group projects, SAT prep, personal development, Toastmasters and a college English course for credit. STI students are awarded a weekly stipend and certificate of completion.
