



STATEWIDE ECONOMIC IMPACT ANALYSIS

This analysis shows how in fiscal year 2022 (FY22) operations, research, construction, visitor and student spending of North Carolina A&T State University, together with its alumni, generated \$1.42 billion in added income for the North Carolina economy and a total economic impact of \$2.4 billion.

The additional income of \$1.42 billion created by the university is equal to approximately 0.21% of the total gross state product (GSP) of North Carolina. The total impact of \$2.4 billion is equivalent to supporting 17,337 jobs. These economic impacts break down as follows.
