

# 2024-25: A Review

- Admissions: A&T exceeded 50K total applications for the first time, drawing a total of more than 51K at UG and graduate levels
- Student Success. Cut student debt, boosted investment in graduate financial aid
- Outcomes. Our 4-year grad rate of 42.5% surpassed the BOG stretch goal by 4% as we produced a record 2,700 graduates
- Digital Support. Launched 5 new Al-driven platforms to boost student success and wellness
- Fiscally Strong. Fitch upgraded our credit and bond ratings to AA, citing strong financial management

- Construction. Work advanced significantly at Bluford Hall, the Resurgent and Urban Food Complex, all now nearing completion
- Academics. Launched DNP and Criminal Justice MS/Ph.D. programs. New AI, Aeronautical & Astronautical Eng. and Physician Assistant programs enroll first classes this fall
- Leadership. Filled senior vacancies in timely fashion: New VCs for Student Affairs, Business & Finance, interim VCs appointed in IT, Advancement, Academic Affairs, Human Resources. New Police Chief, as well
- Athletics. Launched \$1M NIL campaign with AAF, Athletics, Advancement, major donors

# More 2024-25

- Customer Service. Improved answered-call rate in Financial Aid from 33% to 97% on ~1,500 calls per day via temp employees, Al
  - Reinstated shuttle stops to A&T apts.
  - Launched biometric payments at Williams Dining Hall
- Listening Tour connected Chancellor to 42K participants at 200+ stakeholder engagements including high-profile keynotes and strategic partnership announcements

- Careers. A&T Fairs drew unprecedented participation, will now move to First Horizon Coliseum - all employers in single location, no one turned away for space
- Academically Competitive. A&T emerged in national analysis as 2<sup>nd</sup>-most selective university in the Triad, trailing only Wake Forest
- NSF Chair. Elected chair of NSF Committee on Equal Opportunity in Science and Engineering at a time when its charge is of critical importance for higher ed and science communities

# One Hot Summer!



- Our **bond/credit rating improved to AA** by Fitch unprecedented among HBCUs. Major help in A&T financial management.
- We became the first HBCU to host a joint meeting of APLU's Council on Research and Council on Government Relations. Some 325 colleagues from around the country came to A&T to collaborate on the top issues facing research universities today.
- The acclaimed A&T documentary, "Our Blues
  Make Us Gold," debuted on Juneteenth for
  Amazon's Prime Video's 200M subscribers,
  toured Atlanta, Charlotte, Greensboro & Durham
  and screened at the Martha's Vineyard African
  American Film Festival.

## \$30 MILLION: Housing Investments




- Over the past 12 months, we've serviced 1,500 HVAC systems, completed 60 trade projects (electrical, plumbing, locksmithing, general construction), did mold remediation in 420 rooms
- Replaced HVAC systems, installed \$2M in new roofs, replaced shower heads & toilets, used drones to inspect roofing, identify areas for pressure washing, completed Home Depot Innovation Lounge in Blair Hall





• Completed \$250,000 in Student Satisfaction Improvements: ice machines in every hall, video gaming systems, student lounge upgrades. Further improvements will be driven by student input, including SGA executive recommendations.






