## **NC A&T Summer Camps – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)**

### **Who can attend NC A&T summer camps?**

Most camps are designed for rising 3rd to 12th graders. Each camp has specific grade or age requirements, which are listed in the camp descriptions.

### **How do I register my child for camp?**

Registration is completed online through the NC A&T Extended Campus or the camp's specific registration portal. Visit <https://www.ncat.edu/academics/summer-sessions/summer-camps.php> for details.

### **Are there fees for the camps?**

Some camps are free, while others may charge a registration or program fee.

### **What should my child bring to camp?**

Campers should bring any items listed in the camp welcome packet. Common items may include a refillable water bottle, sunscreen, snacks, and a book to read. Electronics are discouraged unless required by the camp.

### **Who supervises the campers?**

All camps are led by trained instructors and supervised by camp staff and counselors who have completed background checks and **Protection of Minors Training**, in accordance with UNC System Protection of Minors Policy (1300.10) and North Carolina A&T State University Protection of Minors Policies.

**What safety measures are in place for campers?**

All camps comply with the UNC System Protection of Minors Policy (1300.10) and North Carolina A&T State University Protection of Minors Policies. Staff are trained and background-checked, and first aid is available on site. Campers are supervised by trained instructors and camp counselors.

**Is transportation provided?**

Transportation is not provided unless otherwise specified. Parents/guardians are responsible for drop-offs and pick-ups.

**What is the drop-off and pick-up policy?**

Parents/guardians must sign campers in and out daily. A photo ID is required for pickup, and only authorized individuals listed on the registration form will be allowed to sign campers.
