



LAAB ACCREDITATION INFORMATION (Updated 4/28/2020)

PUBLIC INFORMATION POLICY:

The Landscape Architectural Accreditation Board (LAAB) requires accredited programs to provide reliable information to the public on its accreditation status and its performance. This information is intended to help potential students make informed application decisions.

ACCREDITATION STATUS:

We are a fully accredited Bachelor’s Degree Program, having received our full accreditation in 1993. We were fully re-accredited from the Landscape Architectural Accreditation Board (LAAB) through 12/31/2023.

STUDENT COSTS:

Tuition and fees annually for a full-time student are currently \$19,197.00 for in state-student and \$32,157.00 for students outside the state of North Carolina. The figures listed below come directly from the Student Financial Services Office and the Graduate Record:

ENTERING CLASS SIZES:

On average, our entering class size ranges from 10 - 20 students. Most students graduate within the expected time of their program. In 2020, we graduated 8 students. In 2019, we graduated 8 students.
